San Diego Trolley Passes

Overview:

Trolley Passes (valid for one day, one rider each) lets you ride MTS Bus and Trolley routes all over San Diego. The Trolley Station is just behind the Town & Country Resort. Day Passes provide unlimited access on all MTS Trolley lines and most MTS Bus routes. MTS Routes go to: popular visitor destinations like Balboa Park, Old Town State Park, PETCO Park, Qualcomm Stadium; major universities like San Diego State and University of California San Diego; great shopping and dining in Coronado, the Gaslamp Quarter, Horton Plaza, Little Italy, and Hillcrest; and some of the best beaches Southern California has to offer from Coronado to La Jolla.

Cost:

1-day, 1-rider Trolley Passes are available for \$5 each

Transportation:

No transportation is provided to the Trolley, as the station is located just behind the Town & Country Resort.
